

CSE 123 Lab Instructions

1. Logging into your account:

Follow the instructions below to login into your lab machine.

1. Open up terminal (for Linux/macOS) or use the [Putty](#) client (for Windows)
2. Type 'ssh <username>@ieng6.ucsd.edu'. If it doesn't work, try using one of the machines ieng6-240.ucsd.edu through ieng6-254.ucsd.edu.
3. Enter your password when prompted.

You will be logged into your account, provided you enter the correct username and password.

2. Submitting your project:

We will be using the '[turnin](#)' command for the project submission.

Course Code: **cs123f**

Once you have completed the project, follow the steps below to submit your project.

1. Copy the project files over to your home directory in the lab machine. E.g: /home/linux/ieng6/cs123f/username/project1.
2. '**cd**' into your directory. E.g: \$ cd project1
3. Type the '**make submit**' command. The project will be submitted.

Note: The '**make submit**' command will tar everything in the directory; create an archive named "project1.tgz" and then run the '[turnin](#)' command on that file to submit the file.
