**SSH Tutorial for Mac**

1. On your dock, click the Finder icon. A new window will open.
2. In the new window, select “Applications” from the left-most pane
3. In the Applications folder, locate the “Utilities” folder
4. Find and open “Terminal.app” in Utilities.
5. In the new command line window, type “ssh USERNAME@ieng6.ucsd.edu” (without the quotes, replacing “USERNAME” with your username), then press enter/return.
6. The first time you connect, the system will print out a message saying that “The authenticity of host ‘ieng6.ucsd.edu’ can’t be established”. Types ‘yes’ and press enter.
7. You will be prompted for your password. Type the password provided in the email and press enter. Nothing will show up as you type your password, but it is working.
8. You should find yourself at a command prompt.
